When Mirvac asked award-winning designer Greg Natale to turn his refined eye to conceive the interiors for this exclusive three-bedroom apartment in the *Pier at Waterfront* apartments on the Brisbane river, it was an opportunity too good to miss.

An impressive example of visionary urban design, *Pier at Waterfront* is the first stage of a development of sleek apartments set on extensive lush parklands, just a short drive from the Brisbane CBD and set amongst some of the most popular and upmarket shops and restaurants of nearby Newstead.

"What better inspiration can you have than a beautifully designed apartment and a water setting?" says Greg. "For this apartment, I selected tones that harmonise with the apartment design and river surroundings.

"I've chosen a scheme of navy and silver to tie in with the apartment's timeless grey and white layout," the designer says. "Navy is such an elegant and versatile neutral that works particularly well here with the space's charcoal tones and ample natural light. And, I've interspersed the palette with pops of amethyst and baby blue to add intensity and drama."

The effect is clean, serene and sophisticated, the ultimate in luxe contemporary living.”
